Volunteer Opportunities

Pre-Vocational Training: **Times: 9:30 am - 4:00 pm Monday - Friday**
Assorted job training skills applicable to skill/ability level of client.

Horticulture Program: **Times: 9:30 am - 4:00 pm Monday - Friday**
Assist clients with planting seeds and various cuttings, transplanting seedlings, and watering/fertilizing all plants, assisting with vegetable gardens, and assisting with holiday flowers.

Ceramic Program: **Times: 9:30 am - 4:00 pm Monday - Friday**
Assist clients with producing greenware and bisque products, i.e., cleaning, glazing, painting and pearlizing Christmas ornaments, vases, etc.

Adult Continuing Education **Times: 9:30 am - 4:00 pm Monday - Friday**
Assist clients in classroom in a continuing academic coursework (TX History; Reading; Math; Science; Life Skills)

Special Olympics: **Times: Varies with each sport**
Assist the adult athletes who compete in various sporting events. It is a year-round program in which athletes are trained for sports, such as: track & field, softball, bowling, cycling, golf and basketball.

After School Program: **Times: 3:00 pm - 5:30 pm Monday - Friday**
Assist senior high school students with socialization skills in ongoing activities, supervise homework and provide respite.

Opportunities include clerical and computer operations, telephoning, writing letters, scheduling and speaking arrangements, and participating in fundraising activities.
