

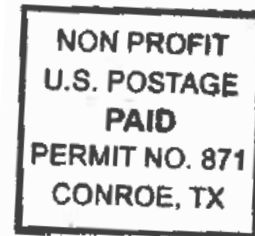

Charles Warner is the father of Ryan W. He passed away after a brave battle with liver cancer. He loved

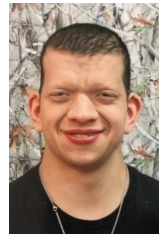
to attend bowling on Wednesday's and cheer the clients on! He never met a stranger and enjoyed telling stories and jokes. He lived life to the fullest!

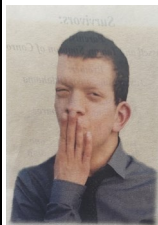

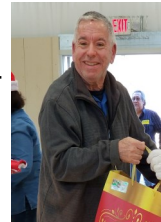
