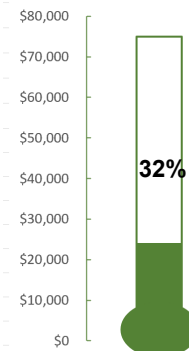

We have nine teams made up of Bridgewood Farms clients, families, staff, board members, and community supporters. The teams represent our day program classes, residential homes, and a team for "Friends of Bridgewood". Each team member's goal is to raise \$500 towards the team goal of at least \$5,000. **We want to raise \$85,000 between November and January.** Every dollar helps us get to the goal!

Bridgewood Farms relies on income from our day program and residential services (70%), signature fundraising events (20%) and corporate grants/general donations (10%) to provide the funding that allows us to effectively accomplish our mission! All these funding sources have been below our "normal" expectations and a slower-than-expected return of clients to our day program. The money raised through this campaign will help us "Grow and Thrive".

More than 97 cents of every dollar raised benefits our clients directly, providing program supplies, client education and training, staff salaries, facility maintenance and so much more. We are confident we will find ways to "Grow and Thrive", focus on the path forward and ensure that we thrive in achieving our mission!

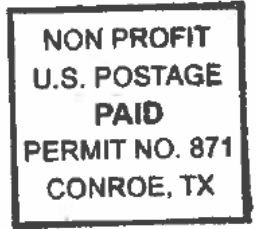
